What is a Search Engine >>>

 a program that searches for and identifies items in a database that correspond to keywords or characters specified by the user, used especially for finding particular sites on the Internet.
















How Search Works>>>

- Search engines, such as Google, create their listings automatically. They "crawl" or "spider" the web, then record the information found in an index.
- When you enter words into a search box, search engine software sifts through the millions of pages in the index to find matches and rank them in the most relevant order.
- The algorithms influencing order are based on number of times the word appears on a site, the quality of the site, page rank and numerous other variables.





Most users want a single search engine that delivers three key features:


- 1. Relevant results (results you are actually interested in)

Internet Searching Tips



Tip 1 >>>

Use quotations

Ex: "top speed cars"

Quotes glue words together; there can be additional words before or after the phrase, but the phrase will always stay together in the results.



Tip 2 >>>

• Use -sign

Ex: cars -toyota

Use the minus sign (-) to eliminate irrelevant results.

Note>>

There must be a space before the minus sign.

There must not be a space between the minus sign and the word you want to eliminate.



Tip 3 >>>

Search within a website

Ex: Barack Obama site:www.cnn.com

This will limit your search to only pages within a specific site or domain, or to exclude pages from a specific site or domain.



Tip 4 >>>

 Search Using most Common Boolean Basics -AND/OR/

Ex: Cars and Bikes

AND: only documents that contain both/all words

Ex: Cars or Bikes

OR: documents that contain either word;



Tip 5 >>>

Search similar pages as you want - related:url

Ex: related:www.cnn.com

This will search for pages(news pages) that are similar to the entered page(cnn news page).

Search similar results to the entered word

Ex: ~car

This will search for similar results to the "car" in different areas.



Tip 6 >>>

Search using the file type: pdf/doc/ppt etc...

Ex: computers filetype:pdf

Only related results on pdf filetype will be shown as the output



Tip 7 >>>

Search using the word define:

Ex: define: Newton's first law

It will shows the web definition that what need for us or it will shows the description as it searches.



Tip 8 >>>

Search using the range or between for results

Ex: car \$10000..\$20000

It will shows the results on the above ranges car types as we entered.



Tip 9 >>>

Search for the unit conversions

Ex: 10.5cm in inches

It will shows the results(Answer) of unit conversion straightaway in the result page as we entered the values



Tip 10 >>>

Calculations /Calculator for mathematics calculations

Ex: 10+25 = ? ,calc or calculator

It will shows the Answer for the question and the calculator display for more calculations

Some more Tips >>>

- time for getting the current time of the zone
- Temp or temperature for getting the current temperature of the area

Advanced Google Searching Tips

It's easy as long as you remember a few, simple commands.



• intitle:terms

 Lets you search for pages that have a particular word or phrase in their title.

• site:domainname

 Lets you limit your search to only pages within a specific site or domain, or to exclude pages from a specific site or domain.

• inurl:url

 Lets you search for pages that have a particular word or phrase in their URL.



Key things to Remember

- Keywords are Key Choose them carefully
- Use Control F to Find on Page
- Take Advantage of Timesavers (Google Instant, Autocomplete,)
- Use Different Media to Filter Results (images, news, blogs, video, books, scholarly sources, etc.)





Key things to Remember cont...

- Use nouns no articles ("a," "the"), pronouns ("he,"
 "it") in your queries
- Use less keywords(6-8) per query
- Spell carefully
- Avoid redundant terms
- Check the "Help" function in you need more help



Key things to Remember cont...

- Use Search Feature Shortcuts define, calculator, conversions, date range, translations, and more)
- Avoid verbs
- use modifiers only when they help to define your object more precisely
- "lowercase is the safest form to use"
- Stop Searching and Start FINDING
